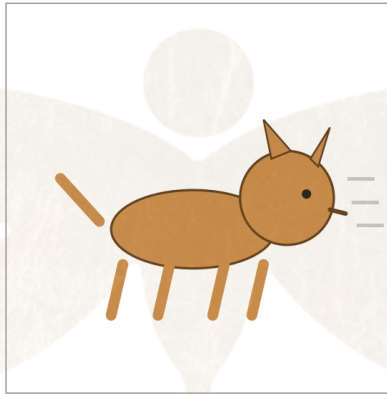


Same Picture, Different Feelings
